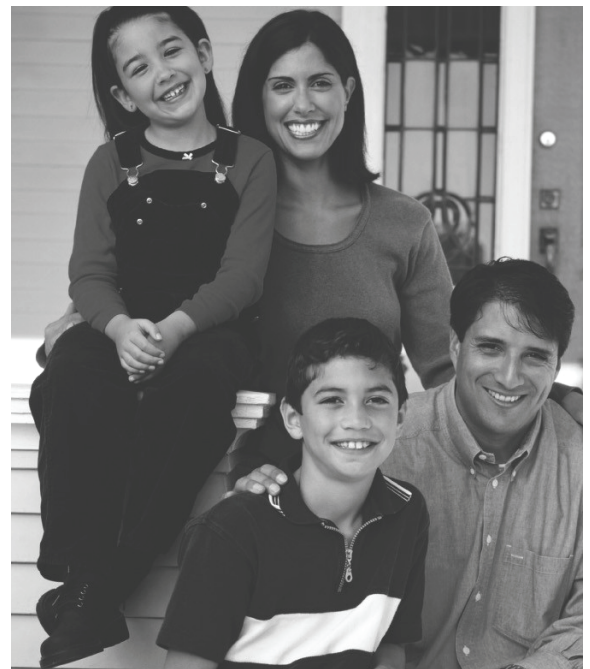

# Florida KidCare

## **Low-Cost or Free Health Coverage for Children!**

Your child may qualify for comprehensive health coverage through Florida KidCare, even if one or both parents work. Getting health coverage for your children before they become sick is very important. Children need regular check-ups so they can grow strong and healthy. Healthy children do better at school and play.

### **What is Florida KidCare?**

It's comprehensive health insurance for children under age 19 who are uninsured. Qualifying for Florida KidCare is based on income and family size. Many non-citizen children may qualify. Florida KidCare includes the following:

- MediKids: covers children ages 1 through 4
- Healthy Kids: covers children ages 5 through 18
- Children's Medical Services Network: covers children birth through age 18 with special health care or emotional needs or ongoing medical conditions
- Medicaid for children: covers children birth through 18

### **How do I apply?**

It's easy! Florida KidCare accepts applications all year. No interview is required. Here's how to apply:

#### **Online application**

#### **Paper application**

### **How much do I pay each month for coverage?**

- Most families pay \$15 or \$20 each month or nothing at all. If you need to pay more, Florida KidCare will let you know.
- You may have small co-payments for some services.

- Vision/Hearing
- Mental Health
- Prescriptions
- Dental
