

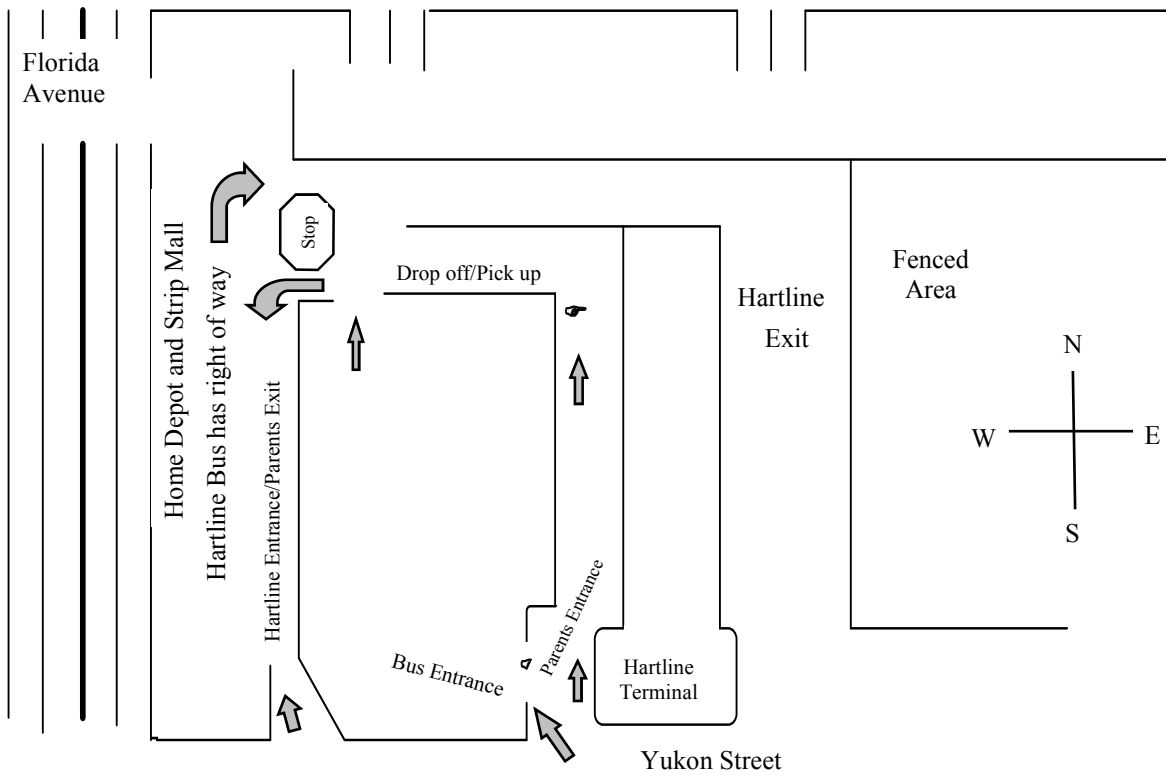
# Procedures for Pick-up/Drop-off at Transfer Ramps

## Yukon Magnet Bus Ramp

Arrival times will be strictly enforced. Transfer arrival times must be no later than **6:30 A.M.** to **6:40 A.M.** Yukon is located east of Florida Avenue and south of Busch Blvd. Enter southeast drive, parallel to Hartline bus exit ramp to front of transfer ramp.

### Morning Drop Off:

- ☞ Drop off students outside of fence. Students are to enter north gate and board first available bus in the designated school lane. Students should not be allowed to walk between cars or into parking places.
- ☞ After transfer has been called at **6:40 A.M.**, and the area has been determined to be clear, **students will not be allowed to enter the gate to board the bus. Parents arriving after the 6:40 A.M. transfer call must transport their children to the designated schools.**



### Afternoon Pick Up:

- ☞ Parents will designate the appropriate afternoon pick up/drop off location. The magnet transfer ramp may be a designated bus stop.
- ☞ Students whose parents have designated a transfer ramp as an afternoon bus stop must carry a badge, furnished by Hillsborough District Schools upon enrollment in magnet schools, for permission to leave the transfer ramp. If a student fails to produce the badge, he/she must return to their network bus for transport to the neighborhood bus stop. Students using magnet transfer ramp as a bus stop must show this badge each day in order to leave the transfer.
- ☞ **Parents arriving after the afternoon transfer must pick up their children from the neighborhood bus stops. Parents causing a disruption at a Magnet Transfer Ramp will forfeit the privilege of using the ramp as a bus stop and shall be liable for prosecution under Florida State Statutes 1006.145, 810.097.**

### Conditions:

- ☞ After three late arrivals, parents will no longer be allowed to use the transfer ramp as a designated bus stop. Parents will be able to choose 1 of 3 options: 1) transport the child to and from school each day; 2) use magnet neighborhood bus stops; 3) return child to the neighborhood school. Three late arrivals will be referred to the District Magnet Office for review.
