Hillsborough County Public Schools is embracing, investing in and deploying programs that ensure all school leadership have the support they need throughout their journey.

During the Assistant Principal Induction Program, participants are assigned an experienced assistant principal mentor. These mentors have a proven track record for success, along with a minimum of three years of experience in the assistant principal role. Assistant principals receive regular contact from their mentor along with face to face collaboration with mentors and peers..

Mentors serve as a thought partner and help develop plans and solutions for accomplishing progress in order to make a difference for teachers, students and the community. These mentor relationships are built upon trust and confidence. Mentors also assist as a professional development collaborator and confidante.

Mentors participate in an extensive training program in order to serve the specialized needs of the new assistant principals and increase their knowledge of how to support their mentees.
