

**EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT EDUCATION:

**I. PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

**III. SPECIFIC CONSIDERATIONS**

**1. Heating/Ventilation/Air Conditioning**

Provide exhaust for the Owner-provided clothes dryer.

**2. Acoustical**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**3. Floor**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**4. Walls**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**5. Ceiling**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**6. Lighting**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**7. Windows**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**8. Doors**

Standard, refer to the General Design Requirements section.

**9. Water**

Classroom

Provide one (1) double sink with hot and cold water, located near the kitchen equipment.  
Provide one (1) electric water cooler, mounted 30" above the floor to the bubbler, located near the Student Toilet/Bath Room.

Laundry Area

Provide connections for the Owner-provided washing machine.

Student Toilet/Bath Room

Provide one (1) toilet and one (1) wall-mounted lavatory with hot and cold water.  
Provide one (1) bathtub with an adjustable height shower head which is removable for use as a hand-held unit.  
Provide one (1) hose bibb and floor drain.

**10. Communications**

Classroom

Provide a clock, intercom speaker and intercom handset in accordance with SDHC standards.  
Provide two (2) AV speakers, mounted on each side of the markerboard.  
Provide data and AV connections and associated power outlets, in accordance with the General Design Requirements section and SDHC standards.

**11. Electrical**

Provide a disconnect switch for the range, located near the range in the Classroom.

**12. Gas and Air**

**13. Safety**

Provide a fire extinguisher in a recessed cabinet, located near the range in the Classroom.

**14. Fencing**

**15. Service Drives**

Not applicable

**16. Parking**

**17. Contractor-Provided Equipment and Casework**

Classroom

Provide nine (9) linear feet of lockable base and wall cabinet, to include the sink and one (1) adjacent bank of lockable graduated drawers, countertop to be 36" above the floor. The kitchen equipment is to be located in this area.

Provide one (1) range with oven and hood.

Provide one (1) dishwasher.

Provide one (1) under-counter type refrigerator with freezer compartment.

**18. Contractor-Provided Instructional Aids**

Classroom

Provide a 12' wide x 5' high markerboard with a 4' wide x 5' high tackboard on one (1) side and a 1' high continuous tack strip above, bottom mounted 24" above the floor.

On an adjacent wall provide a self-healing tackable wall surface which extends from the top of the base to the ceiling and covers the entire wall from corner to corner.

Provide an 18" wide x 60" high framed mirror near the Student Toilet Room, bottom mounted 18" above the floor.

Install an owner-provided projector and mounting bracket, centered on the wall over the markerboard.

**19. Other Considerations**

The TMH Classroom should be located in either the Primary Classroom Area or in the Intermediate Classroom area.

Depending on the number and type of ESE programs selected for this facility, some classrooms may not require the kitchen appliances noted herein. Confirm specific project requirements with SDHC project coordinator.
