

50 Schools 5 Goals

- There will be a dramatic increase in the number of students scoring proficient in ELA and Mathematics within three years of implementation.
- Every school will achieve a “C” grade or higher, and a 90% graduation rate within three years of implementation.
- All schools will sustain a “C” grade or higher for three years.
- There will be no “F” rated schools within the first two years of implementation.
- There will be an increase in the number of highly effective teachers and leaders serving in Achievement Schools.

Achievement Schools get unprecedented support in our district, leveling the playing field for students. These schools are:

- Receiving intense district level support & resources
- Staffed by experienced, highly effective teachers & leaders
- Selected using performance data

Accountability & Support

Schools are divided into 5 Smaller Learning Networks, with Network Supervisors, Support Specialists and Professional Development Specialists.

We have \$9 million in grants to support:

- Professional Development
- Specialized Programs
- Curriculum Materials
- Resources
